## Climate and Health courses

The below courses provide an introductory understanding of the impacts of climate change on health and wellbeing. All courses listed in this section are free and provide a certificate of completion.

<a href="#">Human Health and Climate Change</a>	<a href="#">UN CC:e-Learn</a>	This course provides an introduction to the health challenges, as well as the opportunities, that can be associated to climate change.

It also explores pressing global challenges, such as climate change, biodiversity loss, and emerging diseases.
